## Helpful Information:

EDUCATION: - High School Diploma = Lower pay
Associate's Degree (A.A.) $=2$ years of college
Bachelor's Degree (B.A. or B.S.) $=4$ years of college
Master's Degree (M.A. or M.S) $=2$ years beyond college
Doctorate (Ph.D - Doctor of Philosophy, M.D. - Medical Doctor, J.D. - Juris Doctor - Lawyer $)=$ all of these are $3-8$ years beyond Master's Degree.
****Generally speaking - the more education you have, the more money you'll earn.
ANNUAL SALARY - Information provided usually is given for an entire year (ex. $\$ 35,000$ ). Sometimes, you'll find information such as $\$ 9.00$. This means per hour. You will have to multiply that number by 40 ( for 40 hours of work per week), and then multiply that total by 52 (for 52 weeks in a year). This will give you the annual salary.
